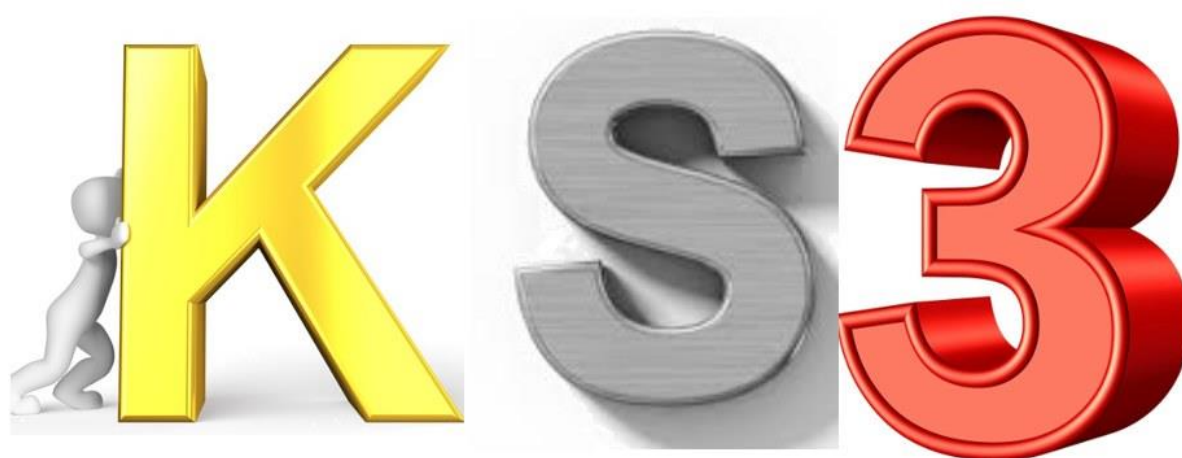
Christmas Special Breakfast

7SF – Dexter Cope for reading 20 books this term!

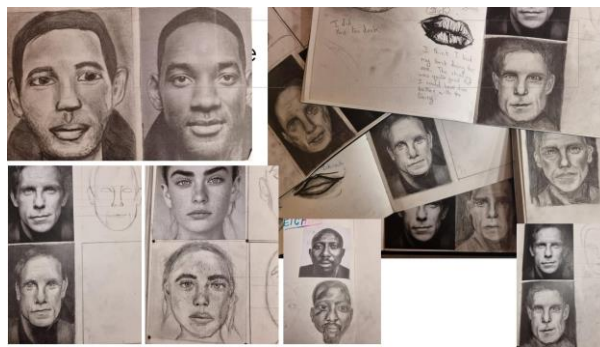
7SK – Esmae Blantford always reading.
